**Topic:** Shapes

**Subtopic:** 2D shapes

**Activity type/skill:** Reading and following instructions

**Literacy focus:** Reading

**Genre:** Instructions

### **Objective**

### **What to do**

# Making a vocabulary box

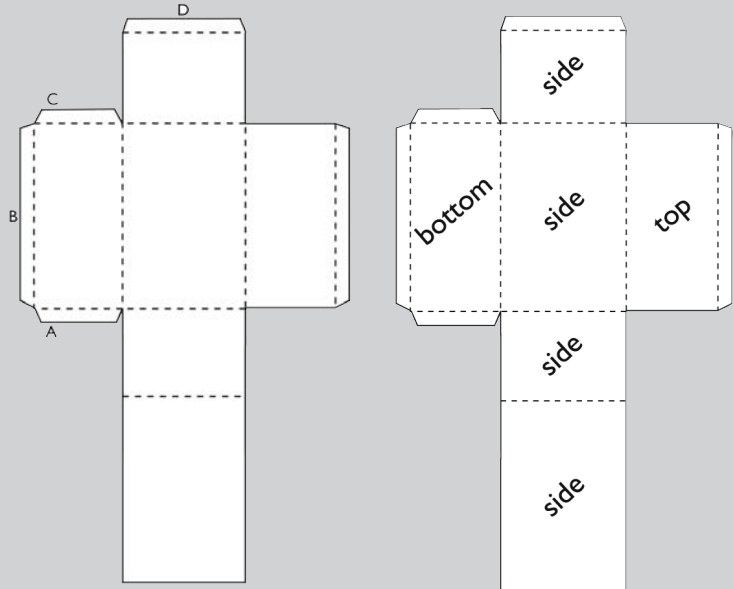
### You will need:

The net on the opposite page.

A pair of scissors

Felt pens or coloured pencils

Glue



### Making the box

Draw stars on the net that will form the top of the box.

Draw circles on two sides.

Draw triangles on the other two sides.

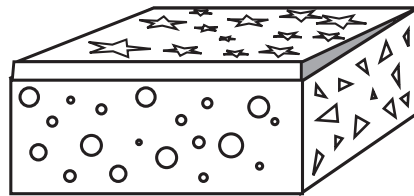
Colour the shapes different colours.

Cut around the outside of the net.

Fold along the dotted lines.

Glue the tabs A, B, C and D to the sides so the box holds together. Don't glue the tab on the top!

Put your word cards in the box and close the top.
