Nouns:	
Common nouns	e.g. water, cup, teabag
Prepositions:	
Of place	in, on etc., e.g. in jug, on tripod
Of time and date	in, at, after, before etc., e.g. after 6 minutes
Articles:	
Definite	the, e.g. the mat
Indefinite	a, e.g. a cup
Pronouns:	
Possessives	my, your, her etc., e.g. your recipe, my instructions
Demonstratives:	this, that, these, those, e.g. This is the recipe. That's the experiment.
Simple conjunctions:	and etc., e.g. Turn on gas and light burner.
Imperatives:	take, put, boil, add etc., e.g. Put the teabag in the cup.
Negation:	e.g. Don't turn on the gas.
Question formation:	
'wh'	what, where, when, who, how many etc., e.g. What do you do first? When do you turn on the gas?
Subject reversal	e.g. Is the temperature higher?
'do' support	
with no auxiliary	e.g. Does the water boil?
Modal 'can'	e.g. Can you hear the dial tone?
Adjectives:	big, small, long, round etc., e.g. Take a big bowl.
Quantifiers:	very, some etc., e.g. very hot, some water
Sequence markers:	first, then, next etc., e.g. First put water in the jug.
Adverbs:	quietly, carefully, slowly, well etc., e.g. Watch carefully, Walk in quietly.
Simple contractions:	what's, I'm, he's, she's etc., e.g. What's the first step?
