Text Structure - Procedure

LINO PRINTING

Materials/Equipment

newspaper, board, ink, lino, art paper, roller, pencil, table, lino cutter

Steps to accomplish goal

1. Using a pencil, draw a pattern on the lino.
2. Cut out the pattern with the lino cutter.
3. Put newspaper on the table.
4. Put the board on the newspaper.
5. Put the lino on the board.
6. Roll ink with a roller, for 2 minutes.
7. Roll ink onto lino.
8. Put art paper on inked lino.
9. Roll paper with clean roller.
10. Take paper off lino.










Use of nouns to name equipment etc.
